WHEREAS, The Village of Hopkins will follow all future mileage rates by the IRS,


WHEREAS the Village of Hopkins will pay all employees the mileage rate of the IRS for any authorized use of their personal vehicles,



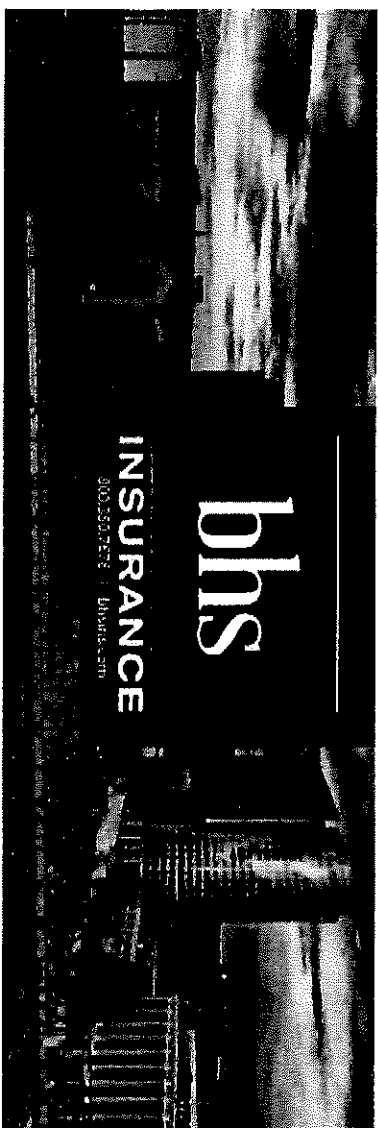

IRS Raises Mileage Rates for Second Half of 2022

To Our Valued Clients:

For the first time since 2011, the IRS has made a midyear adjustment to the optional mileage rate used to calculate the deductible costs of operating an automobile for business and other specific purposes. The agency said the change is in recognition of recent gasoline price increases.

Rate Increase In Announcement 2022-13, released June 9, 2022, the IRS increased the standard mileage rate for the final six months of 2022, starting July 1. During that period, the standard mileage rate for business travel will be 62.5 cents per mile, up 4 cents from the rate effective at the start of the year.
